## INTERESTING STATISTICS

**57% of trans-identifying people avoid using public toilets out of fear for their safety.**

**Although 71% of trans people have a college or university degree, 50% of them have an annual income of less than \$ 15,000.**

**18% of trans people have been refused a job for reasons related to their gender identity, 13% have already lost a job for these same reasons and 34% say they have been the victim of verbal or physical harassment at work.**

**Support from parents and family helps reduce the suicide rate among young trans people by 93%.**
